Gardening Guidelines

Visit When Healthy

Do not garden if you feel ill or have a cold. Do not visit if you have tested positive for COVID-19
within the last two weeks or if you have been in contact with someone who has tested positive for
COVID-19 within the last two weeks.

Hours for Seniors and Higher-Risk Gardeners

- Tuesday: 4:00PM 6:00PM
- Friday: 7:00AM 9:00AM

Maintain Social Distance

 Maintain a 6-foot social distance between gardeners — about a plot distance, or a shovel and an arm's length.

Not More Than 10

 Avoid crowding. Talk with your fellow community gardeners if the garden is full, and schedule accordingly.

Gardening Guidelines

Wear Your Mask

- The CDC recommends that people wear a mask in a community setting. When others are in the garden, demonstrate your care by wearing your mask.
- Keep it Clean and Bring Your Own Tools
 - Ideally, bring your own garden tools and gloves. When you must use shared tools the hose, for example clean them before and after and use garden gloves.
- Sharing tools at this time is **NOT** permitted.
- Wash Your Hands
 - Wash your hands with soap and water before coming to the garden and afterward. Bring hand sanitizer if you have it.
- Communicate With Each Other and your EBGA Board
